A sewer camera is used to diagnose and inspect many sewer problems.

The cable mounted camera is fed through the pipe and a live video picture is sent to the camera monitor.

DVD taping of the inspection can be provided so that the customer may retain a record of the inspection.

Possible Uses:

- Determining blockage location and cause
- Inspecting pipes for cracks and leaks
- Verifying septic tank integrity for certification
- Pipe inspection and preparation for trenchless pipe replacement.
